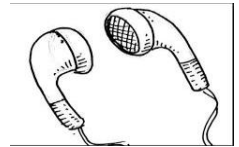

Supplies:

- **Student Planner** (These are no longer provided by the district)

- Texas Instruments **TI-30XIIS** calculator: *Priced at \$12-15, used in math classes through high school.*
- Earbuds/headphones to be brought to class daily for use with computers.
- 2 packets of 100 Notebook paper; 3-hole
- Composition notebook for ELA, *standard size (9.75 x 7.5); at least 80 pages*
- Pencils to last through the year
- 2 binders 1.5" wide (3 ring)- (*AM classes/PM classes*)
- Binder dividers for each binder. (*5 tabs for each*)
- Container of Clorox wipes
- 2 boxes of tissues
- Colored Pencils
- Highlighters
- Erasers
- 2 packs Index cards

from home. Opening the time capsules on the last day of school is a fun way to see HISTORY in your own lives!

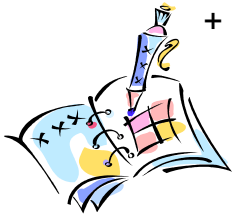


- ❑ Letters from FAMILY/COACHES/TEACHERS: Please ask family members, coaches and/or teachers to write your child a letter and seal it in an envelope. The topic of the letter is writer's choice! Your child will open the letter on the *last day of school*. The more letters the better! This is the best part of the time capsule for many students.
- ❑ Photo: Bring a photo of you from this summer or the first day of school.
- ❑ Collage of Artifacts: Create a collage of artifacts, ideas, pictures that represent you! The collage should be on a sheet of construction/copier paper that can fit into a 9x12 envelope. Examples:
 - A schedule of sports games, dance recital flyer, symbol of favorite sports team, lyrics from a favorite song, a favorite recipe, receipt from your favorite store, postcard from vacation, a map of a favorite place
 - Photographs
 - Pictures
 - Magazine/newspaper headlines that the student reads
 - A souvenir, memento, or keepsake
 - Anything that you think would help remind the student of their life in August.
- ❑ Envelope: Please bring an envelope to store all the Time Capsule components. A 9x12 manila envelope will work to hold all the artifacts. Students can decorate the envelope to reflect the child's persona.

*Remember you and your child must be willing to leave it until the last day of school.
